<p>Investigating And Recommending Practice Innovations In Case Management</p> <p><u>Comments</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is case management (CM) a person or process? It is both – a team approach to individuals including support, rehabilitation connecting to community. Involving the family throughout (establish relationships, asses needs, planning support, advocate services in community)</li> <li>• Definition of CM needs to be defined more clearly.</li> <li>• CM feels like bumper ball</li> <li>• Is there a process for CM flow? Yes however people feel that there is a lack of services.</li> <li>• CM is a service whose many functions are done by service workers in hospitals or community however CM as a service means they will deal with 1 case manager until the goals are met.</li> <li>• In addiction you either say there is no services therefor case managers needs to take it upon themselves</li> <li>• Clients and families are often miles apart the best scenario is everyone is working for 1 goal and information sharing is required.</li> <li>• What are the expectations for case management services?</li> </ul> <p><b>Final Comments</b></p> <p>Worth examining that these services are amongst multiple agencies and how can they work together to provide service.</p> <p>By mid-December will have had 25 interviews with various groups then will draft a report and go into more consultation with family and clients in mid-late Jan and will provide report to LHIN in Feb.
